- ♦ Additional electrical outlets and field parking will be used exclusively by the ASU Pow Wow Committee and Head Staff.
- ♦ Your confirmation of payment will include a letter of your requested arrival time. We will assign booth spaces according to receipt of payments. Arriving later than the time assigned may affect your priority of booth spaces available.
- ♦ Two weekend vendor passes will be given per booth space reserved. Additional discounted passes can be purchased with the application or at the event, there is a limit of 4 discounted weekend passes per space purchased.

Arts and Crafts Exhibitors,

The ASU Pow Wow Committee would like to welcome you to the Twenty Sixth Annual Pow Wow at ASU. We are pleased to have you as part of this year's celebration. To ensure that you enjoy a safe weekend with us, we have developed the following list of rules and regulations:

***BOOTH FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE***

1. There will be **NO** selling of tobacco, sage, sweet grass, pipes, knives, "stringed jewelry," "junk jewelry," "Grand Canyon jewelry, PLEASE DO NOT SELL THESE ITEMS.
2. Items made in China and India must be labeled accordingly.
3. There will be **NO** selling of Hip Hop Merchandise, including T-Shirts, hats, etc.
4. Amplified recorded music will not be permitted.
5. NO dogs or other animals are allowed on the grounds or in booth spaces.
6. Absolutely NO alcohol or drugs will be permitted.
7. Property damage of which you are responsible for will be charged to you.
8. Due to state regulations, camping and open fires will NOT be allowed.
9. No food vendors are allowed (food vending will be provided by the Committee.)
10. Please do not leave children unattended.
11. Any vendor that does not abide by these rules will not be permitted to sell or exhibit their wares.
12. The ASU Pow Wow Committee will not be held accountable for injuries, damages or stolen merchandise/property.
13. You will be allowed to drive onto the field permitting the following conditions. Please observe these rules:
  - Drive on only after you have been assigned a booth space.
  - **Your vehicle MUST be off the field ONE HOUR before the Pow Wow starts, NO EXCEPTIONS!**
  - Please UNLOAD your vehicle completely before setting up your booth.
  - You must remove your vehicle once you have unloaded your wares.
  - You will not be allowed to drive on to Load or Unload during the event, please ask a Committee member to help you with a hand truck or an electric cart.
  - You can load your vehicle at night after the Pow Wow is over.
